Project Narrative

Giving families an array of educational resources is essential in setting up children for successful futures. The combination of an early learning center, the Discover! Children's Museum, and a boys and girls club allows for community members to not only invest in their children, but grow the community in which they live.

With the project located in Downtown Centralia, the new United Learning Center will quickly become an easily accessible community resource, while also being an exemplification of Lewis County's continued growth. Covered walkways and a brick façade integrate seamlessly into the historic downtown, while its LEED Silver certification will set a new bar for both environmental and community stewardship.

The Early Learning Center will be operated via the Bezos Academy, making it more accessible for under-served community members. Four classrooms at 800 square feet each will provide a well-lit, well equipped, healthy, and safe learning environment that will give children practical skills that they can use in their home, via a Montessori approach to education. The ELC will also include a 3000 square foot partially covered playground, an 850 square foot multipurpose room, and a 700 square foot kitchen, to ensure that each child has their every need met.


The Discover! Children's museum, situated next door to the ELC, will provide 4500 square feet of open exhibit space to engage children in hands-on educational activities, as well as an enclosed 200 square foot music room, and a rentable 350 square foot multipurpose room. With plans to establish a larger museum on the same site, the flexible layout of the space will be the perfect canvas to house the boys and girl's club once all phases have been completed.

Through close collaboration with community stakeholders, our design team has developed a concept that matches Lewis County's present day needs, while providing a roadmap to the community's future goals.

At Bezos Academy, the child always comes first.

All children deserve the great start that an excellent preschool provides. Bezos Academy aims to nurture the potential in every child to become a creative leader, original thinker, and lifelong learner by increasing access to early childhood education in underserved communities.

Bezos Academy preschools offer year-round, full-day programming, five days a week, for children ages 3-5 years old from low-income families. Bezos Academy will provide students with all necessary educational supplies and services to set each student up for success, including Montessori materials, books, arts and crafts, field trips, and meals.

Montessori-Inspired Preschool

Core Montessori elements are the foundation of the Bezos Academy Curriculum. The educators are trained in the Montessori method, and each classroom has a full set of Montessori materials. The Montessori approach allows every child to develop naturally — to learn and grow at their own pace. The Curriculum will also borrow from other pedagogies to learn, invent, and improve our ability to support every child's development.

In the classrooms, children follow their interests and engage in hands-on activities using scientifically prepared materials. This enhances a child's intellectual achievement, social cohesion, and emotional regulation.

Given the freedom and support to question, probe deeply, and make connections, Montessori students grow up to be confident, enthusiastic, and self-directed learners and citizens, accountable to both themselves and their community. They think critically, work collaboratively, and act boldly and with integrity.

Boys & Girls Club will offer trained staff who guide, coach, and motivate kids to be successful.








Gymnasium | Recreation Center




